BACKGROUND:

1. Definitions and Interpretation

3. What Does This Policy Cover?

This Privacy Policy applies only to your use of Our Sites. Our Sites may contain links to other websites. Please note that We have no control over how your data is collected, stored, or used by other websites and We advise you to check the privacy policies of any such websites before providing any data to them.

4. Your Rights

- 4.1 As a data subject, you have the following rights under the GDPR, which this Policy and Our use of personal data have been designed to uphold:
 - 4.1.1 The right to be informed about Our collection and use of personal data (see Section 5);
 - 4.1.2 The right of access to the personal data We hold about you (see section 5);
 - 4.1.3 The right to rectification if any personal data We hold about you is inaccurate or incomplete;
 - 4.1.4 The right to be forgotten – i.e. the right to ask Us to delete any personal data We hold about you (We do not retain any personal data from the users of our site other than that described at Section 5));
 - 4.1.5 The right to restrict (i.e. prevent) the processing of your personal data;
 - 4.1.6 The right to data portability (obtaining a copy of your personal data to re-use with another service or organisation);
 - 4.1.7 The right to object to Us using your personal data for particular purposes; and
 - 4.1.8 Rights with respect to automated decision making and profiling.

If We are unable to help, you also have the right to lodge a complaint with the UK’s supervisory authority, the Information Commissioner’s Office.

5. What Data Do We Collect?

5.1 We only collect the following data as a result of you using Our site:

- a) Your IP address;
- b) A time stamp of when you visit each page of Our Site.

5.2 None of the data described at paras 5.1(a or b) is retained or used for any other purpose than Our Site traffic analysis and We do not pass the data obtained to any other third-party.

5.3 In addition, Google Analytics acts as a Data Processor under Our control to monitor traffic flow through Our Site. However, Google does not provide Us with any data that would allow Us to identify a web user in any way and Google are contractually bound to Us to process data gathered from users of Our Site in accordance with Our Policy.

6. How Do We Use Your Data?

Other than for the analytical purposes described at Section 5, We do not process, retain or store any personal information gathered from your use of Our Site.

7. Do We Share Your Data?

We do not share any of your data with any third parties for any purposes.

8. Your Right to Withhold Information

You may access Our Site without providing any data at all.
